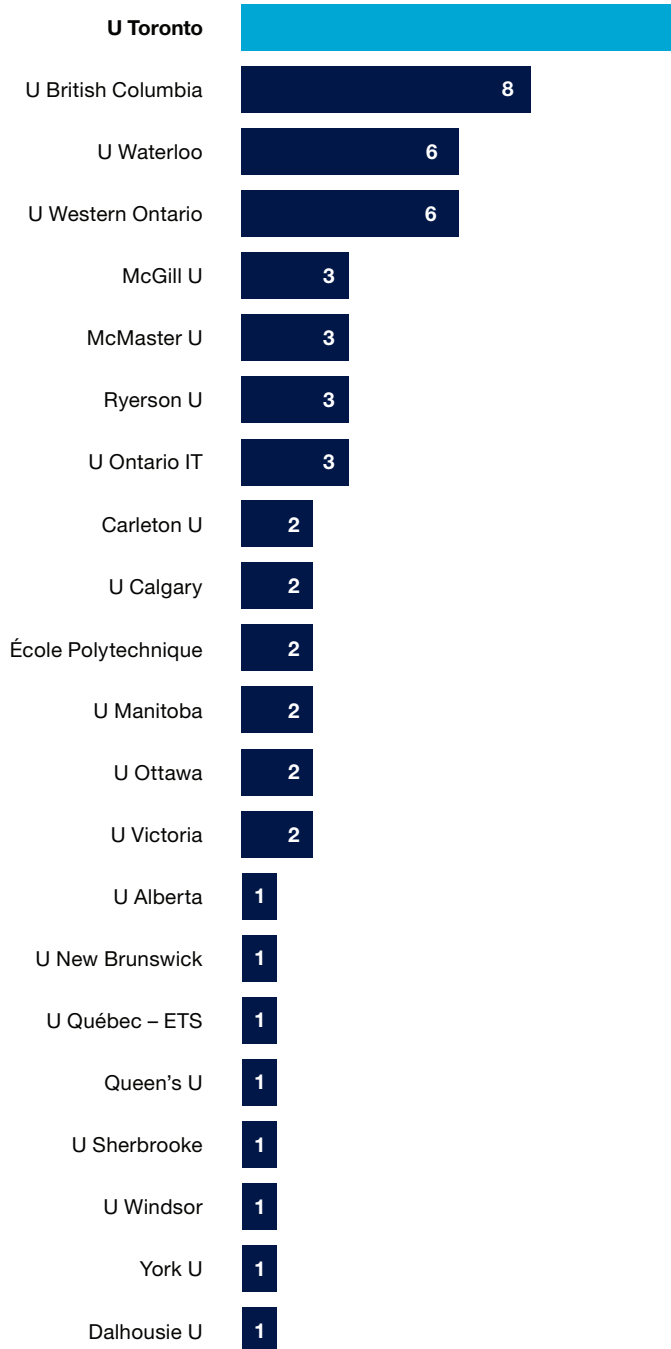




Number of Major Awards Received by U of T Engineering Compared to other Canadian Engineering Faculties, 2010
