Re: Advisory Committee on the Appointment of a Chair, Department of Chemical Engineering and Applied Chemistry: Call for Nominations

Professor Doug Reeve's second term as Chair, Department of Chemical Engineering and Applied Chemistry, ends on June 30, 2011; he is not eligible for reappointment. In accordance with the *Policy on Appointment of Academic Administrators*, we will be commencing the process to seek approval of an Advisory Committee to the Dean on the appointment of a Chair, Department of Chemical Engineering and Applied Chemistry.

The Committee should normally be composed as follows:

- the Dean of the Faculty;
- three to five members of the teaching staff of the department;
- the Dean of the School of Graduate Studies or representative;
- one or two members of cognate departments;
- one or two students;
- a Vice-Dean of the Faculty, where appropriate;
- a librarian, where appropriate; and
- in addition, the committee may include an alumnus/a, a member of the administrative staff and, in the case of professional faculties or schools, a senior member of the appropriate professional community.

Members of Department of Chemical Engineering and Applied Chemistry are invited to nominate individuals to serve on the Advisory Committee *by October 20, 2010*. At this time I welcome any nominations you might have for a Chair, along with a rationale and background for the nomination. Please forward your suggestions to the attention of:
