The following are the key dates from the Guidelines:

	Deadline
Chair places before the Promotions Committee for	
preliminary consideration the names of all Associate	
Professors, Teaching Stream	Early Fall
Associate Professors, Teaching Stream may request that	
they be given detailed consideration for promotion	October 15th
Chair provides written notification to candidates that their	
Promotion Review will take place	October 31st
Candidate provides a list of three appraisers/referees who	
are external to the University	November 15th
Candidate prepares and submits their dossier	December 1st

As per the <u>Policy and Procedures Governing Promotions in the Teaching Stream</u> "Until a sufficient number of teaching stream faculty members have attained this rank, the requirement of having a teaching stream faculty member on the committee shall be waived and the full committee shall be constituted by five (5) tenured faculty at the rank of Professor."
