  - What are current efforts around the faculty to address EDI?


- Move towards "action" (go beyond acute issues)

# **EXAMPLE ACTION (FROM REPORT)**

**Student member** raises issues with Accessibility Testing Services (ATS) {e.g., authorized aids, booking cancellation due to switched sections}

IDEA
Committee
discusses

Committee invites input from
Accessibility Advisor from
Accessibility Services (different from
ATS)

Faculty Registrar takes lead on connecting with ATS and also Undergrad Assessment Committee (UAC)

Assistant Dean Diversity,
Inclusion and Professionalism
brings to attention of Dean and
Vice Dean Undergrad

**UAC** updated Type C exams (Aid sheet permitted) to include three subtypes (C2 and C3 allow digital creation)

Registrar-Office (RO)developed Coversheet template for ATS shared with instructors each term

**RO** in on-going communication with **ATS** to improve process and technology

Accessibility Advisor and ATS Manager speak to Faculty Council

Engineering Computing
Facility (ECF) works with RO
and ATS to support
accommodated computer lab
exams in ECF labs going
forward



# WHERE WE ARE GOING, Q&A

- Takeaways
  - Situational Awareness is helpful.
  - Connections to and collaborations with relevant parties is key.
- Goals (2024-2025 and 2025-2026)
  - Continue developing better situational awareness of EDI work, success, and challenges (individuals, committees, departments, offices) through continued consultation.
  - Based on awareness, identify initial areas of policy and procedure recommendations.
  - Collaborate with relevant standing committees (e.g. UAC and TMRC) and offices to launch Accessibility working groups and begin work on short-term goals (see report).
  - Continue work on EDI Data Working group and issue first report in the first meeting of the 2025-2026 governance cycle (October 2025).
